Re: Protect our Police PAC Endorsement

A newly formed Political Action Committee (PAC) called the Protect our Police PAC has endorsed my candidacy for District Attorney. Their mission is to elect Pro-Police political candidates to public office. I fully support our law enforcement and I support educating our officers and the public on proper police interaction and behavior. What I do not support is the language, images and content included in mailings sent to many homes across Chatham County. I find these mailers to be offensive and an inaccurate representation of my integrity and my beliefs.

This morning, I learned of digital billboards that had gone up around the community with distasteful content. A member of my campaign team contacted the billboard company and learned that these boards had thankfully been pulled down by the PAC around 9:00 p.m. on Sunday, Oct. 25.

Due to campaign regulations, neither I nor my campaign are legally able to contact the PAC or to discuss any content on those mailers or boards with the PAC. Unlike my own campaign ads where I must acknowledge that I approve of the contents, in these mailers and on these boards I had no input nor was I able to approve or disapprove them.
